- Measure, cut, thread, bend, and assemble piping.

- Notify Production Lead of any budget overruns and attempting to fix/resolve them

- Ensure all work meets design specifications and quality standards, minimizing rework and contributing to on-time project delivery.
- Record and submit daily timesheets.
