

SHOP HAND

Job Summary

The function of the Shop Hand is to assist any trades in the shop with handling of materials, shipping & receiving, and ensure the shop remains clean and organized. The Shop Hand is also to perform and any misc. tasks as required in a safe, economical and timely manner. The ideal candidate will be one who likes to be on time, comes to work with a can-do attitude, ready to put problem solving skills to work, and has good attention to detail.

This is an ideal role for students looking for summer work. This is a fixed term contract for 4 months.

Responsibilities include, but not limited to:

Shipping

- Packaging equipment for shipments as per company guidelines, or as instructed by supervisor.
- Working with Production Lead to arrange for production of packing slip and generation all other paperwork required for shipping.
- Delivering parts as required or as instructed to do so
- Entering and printing packing slips as per company guidelines

Receiving

- Organizing, expediting and tracking parts delivery to shop with the purchaser
- Monitoring status of equipment on order and reporting any problems to supervisor and purchaser.
- Completing received parts paperwork according to existing guidelines in a timely manner (within 1 day of parts received in shop).
- Unloading parts, labeling job numbers & PO's and organizing areas in shop.
- Picking up parts as required
- Speaking to suppliers as required in a professional and efficient manner

Shop work

- Organizing and maintaining the shipping/receiving area, pipe racks, general shop cleanliness, yard and lunch room in a logical and tidy fashion.
- Assisting welders/electricians/plumbers as required
- · Organizing areas in shop with parts for jobs
- Assisting with general maintenance of shop and offices for LWR

- High school diploma or GED; no trade certificate required
- Previous shop or warehouse experience an asset

- Valid driver's license with clean record (abstract may be requested)
- Fork Lift operation experience an asset
- Experience in shipping and receiving considered an asset
- Overhead crane certification considered an asset
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs. unassisted is required
